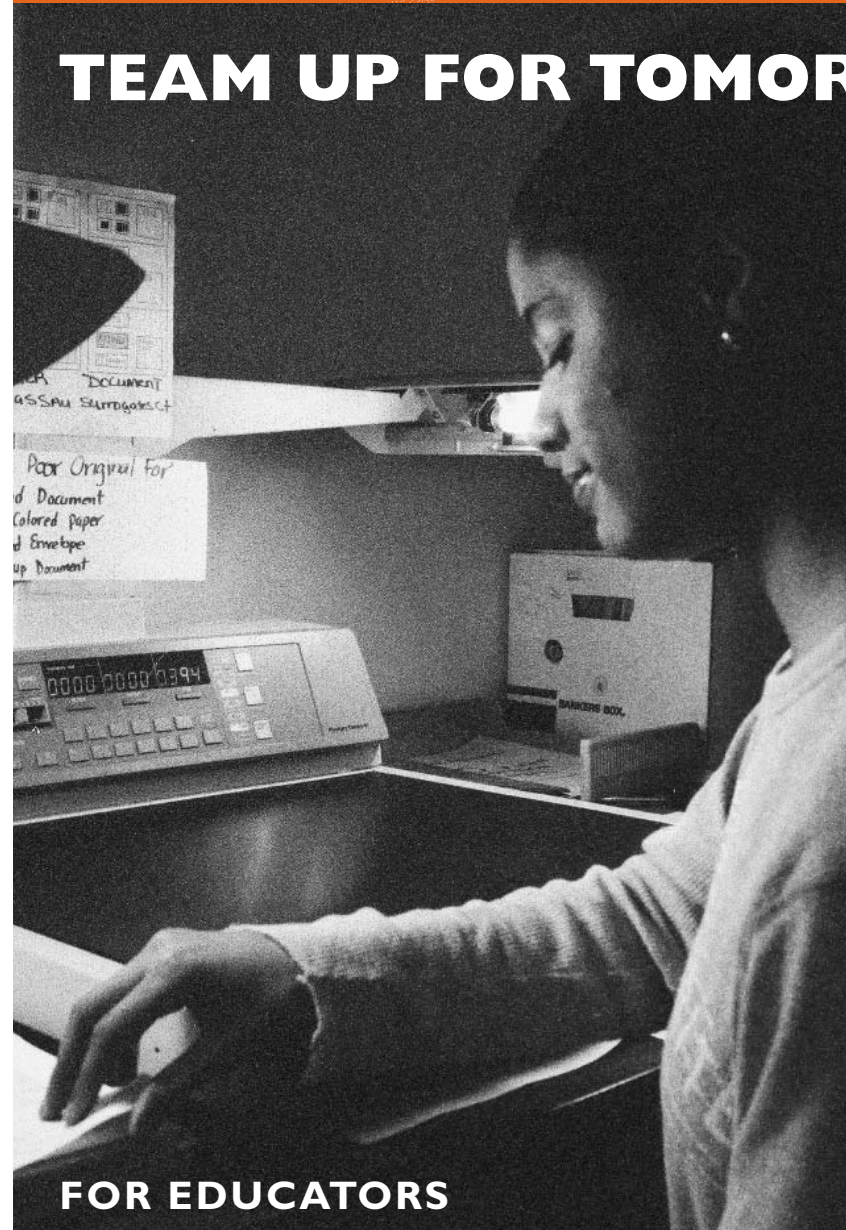

S.T.A.R. works with school administrators and individual teachers to prepare young people with learning and developmental disabilities for the world that awaits them upon graduation. We currently have working partnerships with 20 school districts and are developing career plans for 50 students, ages 15 to 21.

Here's what we do:

At our location:

- Perform psychological evaluations
- Coordinate Services from all participating organizations

At your school:

- Develop personalized plans addressing career, social life and residential options
- Create lesson plans
- Provide guest speakers
- Teach work skills

At the workplace:

- Negotiate student internships
- Identify post-graduation job opportunities
- Provide on-the-job coaching
